**Important Information:**

1. **National Dress Day:**  
It was wonderful to see the children dressed in their National Dress and Kuwaiti colours today.
2. **Late Arrival to and Early Departure from School:**  
May we remind parents that school starts promptly at **07:30 am and finishes at 12:55. Please make the necessary arrangements to have your child/ren at school by this time.**  
**We also have far too many students leaving school early.** Please note that an accurate record is being kept of every student's arrival and departure times.
3. **Boys' and Girls' Hairstyles:**  
Please note that excessive long hair for boys is not allowed, neither is **cutting patterns into the boys' hair** or **shaving only the sides or one side.** As from March 1<sup>st</sup>, 2015, any boy arriving at school with a hairstyle such as these, **will be sent home to have his hair fixed.**  
Girls' hair should be tied back if reaching the shoulders, or longer.
4. **Parents using the Bus Gate:**  
As from March 1<sup>st</sup>, any parent seen dropping their child/ren next to the highway or entering the bus area with their vehicles, will be called-in to sign a final written reminder that this is not allowed. Dropping children next to the highway is **extremely** dangerous, while driving into the bus area with vehicles blocks the flow of buses in and out of school.
