Meeting, Reports and Payments:

As you will be aware we do not have any more Parents meetings for this academic year. Curriculum next year:

From next year pupils in 3 – 6 will study French once a week, and in Years 7-9, twice a week. We hope that the addition of French to the timetable will add to pupils' learning experience here at Oxford.

We will also be offering PE lessons to all Year 10 and 11 pupils in order to ensure that they have the opportunity to participate in exercise activities in school. Please note these lessons will not be examined as IGCSE lessons.
