Teachers will be **revising** all work needed to be covered for the exams as from Sunday, December 7th. Please ensure that your child **asks** his / her teacher to explain any work he / she does not understand during this period of 3 day's revision.

Please be reminded of the exam dates below:

Sun, Dec 7th: Yrs 1 – 3 Islamic exams written in class during their 1st Islam lesson for the week .

Wed, Dec 10th: Yrs 3 – 6 English Papers 1 & 2

Thu, Dec 11th: Yrs 4 – 6 Islamic Exam

Sun, Dec 14th: Yrs 3 – 6 Maths

Mon, Dec 15: Yrs 3 – 6 Home Study (no school)

Tues, Dec 16th: Yrs 5 – 6 Arabic

Wed, Dec 17th: Yrs 3 – 6 Science

- **The school day will finish at 10:30 for all students as from Tuesday, Dec 9th to Thursday, Dec 18th.**

Important Reminders:

- No exam date will be moved / changed for any student wishing to travel.
- Official, stamped doctor and hospital letters are required for any student missing any exam due to illness. Students will then write the make-up exam **on their first day back at school**, so please be prepared.
- Any student caught communicating **in any way** during **any exam**, will have a line drawn through all work completed up to that point, and will only be credited for answers given for the remainder of the exam.

- **Appointments with Teachers / Year Leaders / Head of Primary:**

As a courtesy to any Primary member of staff, no teacher, Year Leader or the Head of Primary will see any parent without an **official appointment**. Staff are extremely busy and cannot leave any student or current issue unattended to meet with parents.

The school has an effective appointment system in place through the ladies at the front desk (Ms. Asmaa or Ms. Manal). We ask our parents to kindly follow the correct procedures.

- **School Uniform:**

With winter approaching, we remind our parents that the correct uniform is to be worn at all times, especially jackets (**Black or Dark blue with NO logo, if not the school jacket**). Correct school shoes are also part of the uniform, which has been communicated to parents on numerous occasions.

We are especially concerned about the boys having *patterns* cut into their hair. This is against the school rules and students guilty of this, will be asked to remain at home until the pattern is removed (this means all hair!)
